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What this builds (transformative SEL): Curiosity (“I wonder”) with a thread of Agency (“I can do it”).

This comic practices **responsible decision-making** through the everyday ache of “everybody has it but me.” The trick (**stop, sort need from want, count what you've got, choose on purpose**) is a tool a child can use in the moment, not a lecture about money. A gentle **financial-mindfulness** thread (needs first, save a little, wait for wants) is modeled by Nana with warmth and no shame.

It's also a deliberate **literacy builder**: comparing and contrasting needs vs. wants. Part 3 is a hands-on sort, and the three Word Power words (NEED, WANT, GRATEFUL) are the topic vocabulary.

This is a practice tool for rehearsing skills, not therapy, counseling, or a clinical service.

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
